

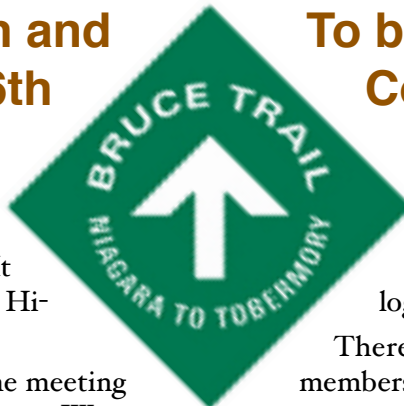


The Annual General Meeting of the Bruce Trail Association
